SEPARATE WASTE COLLECTION



► DOOR-TO-DOOR GLASS COLLECTION

Dedicated rigid bin

WHAT TO PLACE INSIDE: clean bottles and jars, without caps or lids.

IMPORTANT! Mirrors, ceramic, porcelain and crystal objects, drinking glasses, glass-ceramic or Pyrex containers, light bulbs and neon lights must NOT be placed in the glass container. They must be taken to the collection centre.

CLEAN BUT NO NEED TO WASTE WATER. Bottles and jars must be empty and free of residue to ensure better recycling quality. PLEASE USE COMMON SENSE: water is a precious resource.

DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS OR CARDBOARD BOXES.

IMPORTANT! RIGID GLASS BINS MUST BE PLACED OUTSIDE EITHER THE EVENING BEFORE COLLECTION OR BY 5.30 AM ON THE DAY OF COLLECTION. PLEASE NOTE THAT COLLECTION GENERALLY ENDS BY 1.30 PM.

PLEASE REMEMBER: ALL OTHER TYPES OF WASTE - PAPER AND CARDBOARD, PURPLE BAGS, ORGANIC WASTE AND UNSORTED RESIDUAL WASTE - MUST BE TAKEN TO THE COMPUTERISED WASTE COLLECTION POINTS, WHICH ARE ACCESSIBLE 24/7.

HOUSEHOLD USERS: ACCESS TO THE COLLECTION CENTRE IS POSSIBLE WITH THE REGIONAL SERVICES CARD OR ELECTRONIC IDENTITY CARD.

WHAT TO BRING:

- Bulky waste (broken furniture, mattresses, toys, broken shoes, etc.)
- Grass clippings and twigs • Wood (crates, pallets, etc.)
- Iron and other metals • Paper and cardboard packaging
- Hazardous waste (toner cartridges, paint, spray cans, neon lights, batteries)
- Small household appliances (small WEEE, e.g. toasters, mobile phones, hairdryers, etc.)
- Cooking and frying oils
- Used clothing and accessories (such as shoes, bags and belts)
- No fire extinguishers, no plasterboard.

NON-HOUSEHOLD USERS: ACCESS IS GRANTED USING THE APPROPRIATE IDENTIFICATION QR CODE. Non household users listed in Annex L Quinquies of Legislative Decree 152/2006 (as amended) must be registered with the National Register of Environmental Managers (e.g. Category 2-bis) and may only dispose of waste in accordance with current legislation.

► WEEE COLLECTION (Large household appliances)

WHAT IS COLLECTED: televisions, refrigerators, washing machines, computers, and other large household appliances.

► Home collection of bulky waste

WHAT IS COLLECTED:

furniture, sofas, mattresses, garden furniture, etc.

► Automatic bag dispenser

PIAZZA IV NOVEMBRE (near the town hall) - DERVIO

The dispenser provides users with red bags for accurate waste measurement, as well as other types of bags supplied by the Municipality.

► EcoCasetta

VIA MONASTERO - DERVIO

▶ NEW COMPUTERISED WASTE COLLECTION POINTS

Paper and cardboard, purple bags, organic waste and unsorted residual waste must be taken to the new computerised waste collection points, which are accessible 24/7.

Only glass continues to be collected door-to-door for all users according to the provided calendar.

▶ Tips for correct use of Waste Collection Points

- Press the steel start button and wait for the message "Bring your card closer to dispose" to appear on the display.
- Hold your health card or CIE card near the optical reader with the red light, without touching it, at a distance of about 10 cm.
- If the optical reader with red light is vertical, rotate the card in the same direction to allow proper scanning.
- If your card is not recognised, request a replacement QR code from the municipal offices.
- Use the handle to open the chute. For multiple disposals, hold down the opening pedal.
- Make sure the waste does not block the chute.

▶ WASTE COLLECTION POINTS FOR PLASTIC, CANS AND TETRAPAKS

Do not insert overly full purple bags, as they may block the disposal chute

WHAT TO PLACE INSIDE:

Plastic: bottles, jars and trays, blister packs and shaped packaging, bags and sachets, egg cartons, fruit and vegetable nets, detergent, cosmetic and liquid soap bottles, polystyrene packaging, crates (e.g. fruit), cellophane and film, small plant pots, clothes hangers.

Aluminium and other metals: beverage cans, food trays and tins (e.g. tuna, tomatoes), aluminium coffee capsules, crown caps, jar lids, clothes hangers, tubes for pre-rolls or cosmetics (e.g. toothpaste), aluminium foil, shaving foam and cream cans.

Tetrapak: beverage containers (milk, wine, fruit juice, etc.).

IMPORTANT! Biodegradable and compostable products (e.g. bags, plates) must NOT be placed in the purple bag for light multi material waste. Toys and other plastic or rubber items should be disposed of in the unsorted waste bin or taken to the collection centre.

CLEAN BUT NO NEED TO WASTE WATER. Containers must be empty and free of residue to ensure better recycling quality. PLEASE USE COMMON SENSE: water is a precious resource.

CRUSH CONTAINERS TO REDUCE THEIR VOLUME.

Do not place smaller bags inside larger bags.

▶ WASTE COLLECTION POINTS FOR PAPER AND CARDBOARD

Fold cardboard boxes to reduce volume

WHAT TO PLACE INSIDE:

paper, cardboard and card, newspapers, magazines, books, notebooks, sheets of paper, paper envelopes and bags, cardboard boxes (detergents, shoes, etc.), pastry trays, cardboard packaging (pasta, rice, cereals, eggs, etc.), pizza boxes (without pizza!), etc.

IMPORTANT! Waxed or plastic coated paper and baking paper must go in the unsorted waste. Tetrapaks go in the purple bag!

CLEAN BUT NO NEED TO WASTE WATER. Bags and boxes must be empty and free of residue to ensure better recycling quality.

Do not place paper or cardboard inside plastic bags.

▶ WASTE COLLECTION POINTS FOR ORGANIC WASTE

Use only biodegradable and compostable bags

WHAT TO PLACE INSIDE:

kitchen food waste, fruit and vegetable scraps, bones and fish bones, tea and chamomile bags, coffee grounds, eggshells, cut flowers, toothpicks and wooden cutlery, compostable tableware (certified according to the UNI EN 13432 standard).

IMPORTANT! Pet litter (even compostable), animal excrement, paper tissues, mussel and clam shells, cigarette butts and compostable nappies must be disposed of in the unsorted waste bin.

BIODEGRADABLE AND COMPOSTABLE TABLEWARE: please check the packaging for certification marks confirming that the product is biodegradable and compostable.

▶ WASTE COLLECTION POINTS FOR UNSORTED WASTE

Red bag

WHAT TO PLACE INSIDE:

All non recyclable-waste, including plastic cutlery, toys, X rays, broken shoes, sanitary towels, bedding, animal excrement, syringes with caps, mussel and clam shells, cigarette butts, paper tissues, rags, document envelopes, thermal paper receipts, candles and tea lights, hard plastic items (e.g. household items, glasses), pens and markers, masks, cosmetics.

IMPORTANT! Expired medicines, batteries, light bulbs and ceramics must be disposed of in the appropriate containers or at the collection centre.

Animal litter: may also be taken to the collection centre, where the service is available.
